

RECYCLING HAS CHANGED

A recycling dumpster has been placed in the parking lot behind the Municipal Building and is available for residents to drop off their recyclable materials at any time. The dumpster will be emptied on a weekly basis.

Please understand that it is **extremely important** that materials placed in the dumpster, are actually recyclable. The service provider scrutinizes the contents of the dumpster; if there are too many non-recyclable materials, none of the material will be recycled and will instead be sent to a landfill.

ITEMS WHICH CAN BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLING DUMPSTER

- Glass bottles or jars with lids attached
- Plastic bottles or jugs with lids attached
- Metal cans
- Flattened cardboard
- Non-mixed paper – remove bubble wrap from padded envelopes and plastic windows from paper envelopes

ITEMS WHICH CANNOT BE PLACED IN THE RECYCLING DUMPSTER

- Plastic bags of any kind
- Items which are wet
- Items which contain food or food residue, including pizza boxes with grease residue
- Bubble wrap or Styrofoam
- Unattached lids – they are too small – instead, attach them to the bottle or jug they came from

ONLY place these items in the recycling container
