

From the Police Chief...

Residents: Throughout the COVID Pandemic officials in Lebanon Township have kept an open dialogue with each other. We have monitored the situation closely while ensuring compliance with the executive orders imposed by the Governor.

Executive Order 133 re-opened our county and state parks as well as golf courses. The re-openings came with restrictions understandably and the wording in EO 133 has placed some restrictions on our Municipal Park as well.

From this date and until rescinded the memorial park playground, pavilion and restrooms will be closed. In addition, the basketball courts will remain open but with the caveat that there be no organized or contact sports throughout the park. Activities on the basketball court will be limited to 10 or less individuals and will be monitored by the Lebanon Twp. Police Department.

Consistent with Paragraph 3 of Executive Order No. 107 (2020), visitors must practice social distancing and stay six feet apart whenever practicable; this excludes immediate family members, caretakers, household members, or romantic partners.
