Mr. Duckworth introduced a set of Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs), which he thought would be a good way to communicate with the public about the program. He also suggested that the Commission develop a handout for each property. Committeeman Laul introduced a draft of the permit application for review. Discussion ensued. Consideration must be given to EIFP-restricted areas. Feedback was provided to both Mr. Duckworth and Committeeman Laul. It was decided that property handouts would not be included as part of the hunting package and focus should be on the permit application, which much be reviewed and approved by Township Committee. Applicants would force rank their desired properties and would be required to provide proof of insurance.</p> <p>Tire Recycling.
