R.S. 52:27BB-52: A local officer or member of a local governing body who, after a date a fixed for compliance, fails or refuses to obey an order of the director (Director of Local Government Services), under the provisions of this Article, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, may be fined not more than one thousand dollars

(\$1,000.00) or imprisoned for not more than one year, or both, in addition shall forfeit his office.
