## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT PROPOSAL TO THE HUNTERDON COUNTY OPEN SPACE, FARMLAND & HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST FUND

**WHEREAS,** the Hunterdon County Open Space, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("County Open Space Trust Fund"), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Lebanon desires to further the public interest by obtaining a matching grant of \$56,000.00 from the County Trust Fund to fund the following project: Memorial Park Volleyball Courts Renovation Project; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lebanon Committee has reviewed the Municipal Park and Recreation Grant Program application and instructions, and desires to make an application for such a matching grant and provide application information and furnish such documents as may be required; and

WHEREAS, the County of Hunterdon shall determine whether the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Municipal Park and Recreation Grant Program and the Hunterdon County Open Space Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Lebanon is willing to use the County Open Space Trust Fund in accordance with such rules, regulations and applicable statutes, and is willing to enter into an agreement with the County of Hunterdon for the above named project and ensure its completion on or about the project contract expiration date.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Lebanon, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey does hereby authorize the application for such a grant; and

- 1. That it is hereby authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of September 20, 2024, as established by the County.
- 2. That, in the event of a County Trust Fund award that may be less than the grant amount requested above, the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Lebanon has, or will secure, the balance of funding necessary to complete the project, or modify the project as necessary.
- 3. That the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Lebanon is committed to providing a 25% cash match for the project.

- 4. That only those park improvements identified and approved in the project application, its Project contract, or other documentation will be considered eligible for reimbursement.
- 5. That the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Lebanon agrees to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations in its performance of the project.

That this resolution shall t	take effect immediately.

Matters involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective or current public officer or employee of the public body, where all individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected have not requested in writing that the matter(s) be discussed at a public meeting; the employee(s) and/or general nature of discussion is: CFO position. And whereas the public disclosure of such information at this time would violate the employee(s) privacy rights; therefore, this information will be withheld until such time as the matter is concluded or the threat to privacy rights no longer exists;
Deliberation occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty or loss of a license or permit.
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the Mayor and Committee hereby declare that their discussion of the subject(s) identified above may be made public at a time when the Township Attorney advises them that the disclosure of the discussion will not detrimentally affect any right interest or duty of the Township or any other entity with respect to said discussion.
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the Mayor and Committee, for the reasons set forth above, hereby declare that the public is excluded from the portion of the meeting during which the above discussion shall take place.
