



DEER HUNTING FOR DEER MANAGEMENT & FOREST STEWARDSHIP IN LEBANON TOWNSHIP



The **Lebanon Township Forest Stewardship Master Plan** identifies a Deer Management Program as a key mechanism to achieving forest regeneration, biodiversity, & native species restoration.

The township properties below are open seasonally to permit-holding deer hunters. Hunters are to apply for a permit with the Lebanon Township Police Department.
