**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING SPECIFIC TRACTS OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED
PARKS AND OPEN SPACES TO BE INCLUDED IN LEBANON TOWNSHIP'S DEER
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 269, ARTICLE 269-7 OF
THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LEBANON FOR THE HUNTING SEASON
BEGINNING IN SEPTEMBER 2026 AND ENDING IN FEBRUARY 2027**

WHEREAS, as part of a comprehensive deer management plan and for the purpose of reducing the Township's white-tailed deer population, the Township Committee of the Township of Lebanon amended Chapter 269, "Park and playgrounds" of the Code of the Township of Lebanon to allow limited hunting on the Township's parks and open spaces for the purpose of managing white-tailed deer; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 269 of the Code authorizes the Township Committee to designate annually by resolution which parks and open spaces will be made available for hunting through the Township's municipal deer management program and during which dates; and

WHEREAS, a Lebanon Township Committee designee will execute the lottery selection for Fall Bow on August 7, 2026, Permit Bow on September 25, 2026, Six-day firearm (for select properties) on November 6, 2026, and Winter Bow on December 4, 2026. Lottery winners will be notified and given two (2) weeks to pick up permit documentation and deer harvest report forms; and

WHEREAS, a permittee is a licensed hunter who has been issued a permit to hunt deer through the Township's municipal deer management program; and

WHEREAS, the Deer Harvest report will be required to be returned to the municipal office by March 2027, failure to return this document will exclude applicants from the 2027-2028 season.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lebanon, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Pursuant to Chapter 269 of the Code of the Township of Lebanon, the hunting of white-tailed deer will be allowed on the properties listed below within the timeframes established by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Fish and Wildlife Program ("State"). The anticipated hunting season will be from September 12, 2026 to February 20, 2027 subject to the restrictions and conditions set forth below. In the event any of the dates below are inconsistent with any dates established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution.

A. Anthony Preserve

1) Flintlock Place: Bow and Six-Day Firearm

Designation: Block 49 Lot 89.01

Location: 41.6 acres

- Access: Public access to this property is off the cul-de-sac on Flintlock Place through a narrow access, which currently does not have an established trail.
- Bow Hunting Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to bow hunting during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than four (4) municipal deer management bow permits shall be issued for this property.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.
- Six-Day Firearm Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to firearm hunting during six-day firearm season established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than one (1) municipal deer management firearm permit shall be issued for this property.
 - Permittees shall maintain full awareness of the 450-foot safety zone, exhibit utmost due diligence in mapping their surroundings, and ensure absolute compliance with this perimeter at all times.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.

2) Anthony Road: Bow and Six-Day Firearm

Designation: Block 49 Lot 4.02

Location: 57 acres

- Access: Public access to this property is off Anthony Road. This access currently has limited roadside parking and no established trail.
- Bow Hunting Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to bow hunting during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:

- No more than five (5) municipal deer management bow permits shall be issued for this property.
- Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
- Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety
- Six-Day Firearm Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to firearm hunting during six-day firearm season established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than one (3) municipal deer management firearm permits shall be issued for this property.
 - Permittees shall maintain full awareness of the 450-foot safety zone, exhibit utmost due diligence in mapping their surroundings, and ensure absolute compliance with this perimeter at all times.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.

3) Shady Lane: Bow Only

Designation: Block 49 Lot 89.02

Location: 15.16 acres

- Access: Shady Lane is a private road and shall only be used for access by residents of Shady Lane and their guests. Public access to this property is through an easement off Block 49 Lot 89.01, which currently does not have an established trail.
- Bow Hunting Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to bow hunting during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than three (3) municipal deer management permits shall be issued for this property.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.

B. Sun Mountain Preserve: Bow and Six-Day Firearm

Designation: Block 24 Lot 2.01

Location: 65 acres

- Access: Public access to this property is at the end of Sun Mountain Street. This access currently has limited parking and an unmarked trail.

- Bow Hunting Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to bow hunting during all regular deer hunting seasons established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027, including fall bow, permit bow, winter bow. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than five (5) municipal deer management bow permits shall be issued for this property.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.
- Six-Day Firearm Seasons/Dates: This property shall be open to firearm hunting during six-day firearm season established by the State for Deer Management Zone 8 for 2026-2027. The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than one (3) municipal deer management firearm permits shall be issued for this property.

The specific dates on which hunting will be permitted are established by the State for the appropriate season, the State's dates shall apply, unless limited in specific instances by the Township of Lebanon in accordance with paragraph 2 of this Resolution:
 - No more than three (3) municipal deer management permits shall be issued for this property.
 - Hunting on Sundays shall be strictly prohibited.
 - Permittees using elevated tree stands on Township property shall use a full-body safety harness.
2. Except as otherwise set forth herein, hunting shall be allowed only during the dates designated by the State for the applicable seasons listed above. The specific dates shall be set forth on each permit, pending approval of the 2026/27 Game Code. Any dates set forth on the permits notwithstanding, the Township may make it a condition of any permit that hunting not take place on certain days as may be necessary to protect public health and safety.
 - a. Fall bow: September 12 - October 30, 2026 (pending approval of Game Code)
 - b. Permit bow: October 31 – December 24; December 26-31, 2026 (pending approval of Game Code)
 - c. Winter bow: January 1 - February 20, 2027 (pending approval of Game Code)
 - d. Six-day firearm: December 7 – 12, 2026 (pending approval of Game Code)
 3. The hunting, shooting or killing any other game is strictly prohibited.
 4. Hunting may take place only pursuant to the requirements set forth in Chapter 269 of the Code of the Township of Lebanon and all applicable State and local regulations. In the event of any inconsistency, the more restrictive standard shall govern.
 5. Warning signs shall be posted at the entrances to the properties designated above; in addition, the properties shall be posted in accordance with any specific terms and conditions of the individual permits.
 6. A press release and a legal notice in a form approved by the Township Attorney notifying the public of the above designated dates and locations shall be published

on the Township's website and shall be submitted to the Township's officially-designated newspaper(s) as well as such others newspaper(s) as may be deemed advisable to publicize the above-referenced dates and locations as widely as possible.

7. The Township reserves the right to modify the conditions and restrictions set forth above at any time, including after issuance of the 2026-2027 permits, in the interests of the public health, safety and welfare of Township residents.
8. Permittees are limited to the use of one portable tree stand per permittee.
9. No person shall be awarded multiple permits for a single property.
10. A person may only be awarded a single permit across all properties as part of the lottery for that season. After the lottery, a person may seek permits for additional properties if available
11. Any permittee who harvests at least two deer on a single permit, one of which must be a doe, shall be offered the right of first refusal in purchasing a permit for the same season and property during the 2027-2028 deer management program.
12. The Township Committee is considering amending the rules and regulations set forth in §269-7 of the Township Code to include a type of "hunter mentoring program" for the 2026-2027 bow hunting season. Therefore, the following shall apply only to the September 2026 to February 2027 bow hunting season: Any licensed bow hunter permittee who is at least twenty-one (21) years of age or older shall be permitted to have one (1) additional licensed bow hunter per day who is under the age of eighteen (18) years of age accompany the licensed bow hunter permittee, provided that the hunter under the age of eighteen years of age has obtained the requisite State license and complied with all conditions of that license, provides a copy of a certificate of insurance confirming general liability insurance, and obeys all rules and laws regarding hunting in NJ pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-5, other applicable laws, and Township requirements. All licensed bow hunter permittees who elect to have a licensed bow hunters under the age of eighteen (18) years of age accompany them must 1) obtain, possess and provide to the Township, written permission and a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement in a form provided by the Township and in favor of the Township of Lebanon, from the parent or guardian of the hunter under the age of eighteen (18) years of age, 2) accompany and supervise the licensed bow hunter under the age of eighteen (18) years of age and remain within sight of, and in direct voice contact with, that hunter at all times while in the field, 3) not have any prior Fish and Wildlife violations in NJ or any other state, and 4) agree to be held responsible for any/all violations committed by the licensed bow hunter under the age of eighteen (18) years of age.
